STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Membership of Municipal Conservation Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 3851, amended. Section 3851 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 203 of the public laws of 1965, and as amended, is further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence, the following 3 new sentences;

In the event that the total number of legally appointed members is reduced by resignation, death or expiration of terms, a total or 3 legally appointed members shall constitute a legal body to conduct the business of the commission, pending appointments by the municipal officers. The municipal officers shall fill such vacancies within 60 days of their occurrence. The conservation commission may appoint associate members without voting power.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to deal with vacancies on Municipal Conservation Commissions.
