**AN ACT to Change the Open Season for the Taking of Scallops.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 4002, amended.** The first paragraph of section 4002 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 337 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful for any person to fish for or take scallops from the coastal waters of the State between the 15th day of April and the ~~31st~~ 30th day of the following ~~October, inclusive~~ November of each year, except as provided in this section.
