SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 668, L. D. 873, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Stop-sale Orders under Maine Economic  
Poisons Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the  
Statement of Fact, the following underlined sentence:

'Stop-sale order under this section shall mean a written  
order issued by the commissioner or his agent to prohibit  
the further distribution of any economic poison or device.'
