STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Corporal Punishment of Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 473, sub-§ 14, additional. Section 473 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 14 to read as follows:

14. Corporal punishment. No teacher or other employee of a school committee or board shall have the right to inflict corporal punishment upon any pupil, for disobedience or misconduct, except that a pupil may be restrained from any action which appears to present danger to himself or others but such restraints must be administered without malice and in moderation.
