HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 678, L. D. 885, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide a Maine Citizen's Preference on State Civil
Service."

Amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause (same in L. D.) the
underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§ 557." (same in L. D.) by striking out all of
the last underlined sentence.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to retain educational
qualifications for state jobs and to eliminate the appropriation
from the bill.
