AN ACT Defining Health Insurance on a Franchise Plan.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 24-A, § 2740, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 1 of section 2740 of Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

A. Four Three or more employees of any corporation, copartnership, or individual employer or any governmental corporation, agency or department thereof; or

STATEMENT OF FACT

The reduction from 4 to 3 employees needed to qualify for franchise health insurance will conform more nearly with general practice and permit more small Maine companies to qualify for this form of health insurance.

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
