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**AN ACT** Relating to Sale Price of Liquor.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 451, amended.** The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 451 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in ~~one store~~ **2 stores** and establish at ~~that store~~ **those stores** the price to which the 10% discount in section 204 shall be applicable.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would allow discount liquors to be sold at a 2nd location.
