COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 708, L. D. 913, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Marking of Egg-bearing Lobsters."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the lobster industry is one of Maine's great natural resources; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to protect the industry as soon as possible by making the marking of egg-bearing lobsters uniform; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for an emergency clause and preamble.
