AN ACT Amending Fee Schedule for Registered Nurses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 32, § 2207, sub-§§ I 3, amended. Subsections I to 3 of section 2207 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 206 of the public laws of 1965, are further amended to read as follows:
 - 1. Examination. By examination: Fee of \$25 \$30 payable on application;
- 2. Reexamination. By reexamination: Fee to be determined by the board based on the number of areas to be covered and not to exceed \$25 \$30;
- 3. Endorsement. By endorsement: Fee of \$5 \$25 payable on application and an additional fee of \$15 to complete the requirements for the issuance of the license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

- r. A cost analysis of the examination for registered nurses revealed the present charge does not cover the actual cost of the examination.
- 2. The charge of purchasing the test booklets has been increased as of 1973, making it necessary to increase the cost of the examination application.
- 3. The sole income of the Board of Nursing is from fees. These must be adequate to cover the cost of the particular activity.
