AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Androscoggin County: County commissioners, ~~\$3,400~~ \$3,774; chairman, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,440; clerk of courts, ~~\$9,850~~ \$10,933.50; county attorney, \$8,500; first assistant county attorney, \$6,000; second assistant county attorney, \$6,000; county treasurer, ~~\$7,300~~ \$8,103.00; sheriff, ~~\$9,250~~ \$10,267.50; register of deeds, ~~\$8,050~~ \$8,935.50; judge of probate, ~~\$7,250~~ \$8,047.50; register of probate, ~~\$7,450~~ \$8,269.50;
