AN ACT Relating to Use of Waters of Kezar Lake by Westways
Maintenance Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Westways Maintenance Corporation; use of waters of Kezar Lake. Westways Maintenance Corporation, a nonstock corporation organized and existing under the general laws of the State of Maine, is authorized to take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Kezar Lake to carry out any or all of its proper corporate purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Westways Maintenance Corporation is a nonprofit homeowners association organized to own and manage common riparian areas, roadways and certain utilities and to provide maintenance services for Westways-at-Kezar on the east shore of Kezar Lake, including the furnishing of water from Kezar Lake to approximately 50 residential properties situated contiguous to Kezar Lake.
