**AN ACT to appropriate the Amount of \$1,460,000 for Parking Garage
Facility for the Capitol Complex at Augusta.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau of Public Improvements, the sum of \$1,460,000 for parking garage facility for the capitol complex at Augusta. The breakdown shall be as follows:
