HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 735, L. D. 938, RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Spruce Budworm Control.

Amend said Resolve in the title by adding at the end before the period the following: 'and Relating to Future Control in the Unorganized Territory'

Further amend said Resolve in the last line before the emergency clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the period and inserting in place thereof the following: '; and be it further'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'<u>Resolved</u>: That the Legislature will neither authorize nor approve the expenditure of additional public funds during any future special or regular session of the Legislature to control spruce budworm on forest lands owned by private persons or entities unless and until the owners of such forest lands shall have first quitclaimed to the State all of their respective right, title and interest in and to the public reserved lots, both located and unlocated, within every township or tract upon which spruce budworm control is proposed or contemplated.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is concerned with the future control of spruce budworm in the unorganized territory.
