AN ACT Regulating Speed of Motorboats on the Songo and Crooked Rivers,
Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 258, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 258 to read as follows:

§ 258. —Songo and Crooked Rivers; use of power boats

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat on the Songo River and on the Crooked River from Edes Falls Dam to where it joins the Songo River, both located in Cumberland County, at any speed greater than headway speed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to regulate the speed of motorboats on the Songo River and on part of the Crooked River.
