Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at the end,
before the period, the words 'or Printed'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line (3rd in L. D.)
by inserting after the underlined word "typewritten" the
underlined words 'or printed'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line (4th and 5th in L. D.)
by inserting after the underlined word "typewritten" the
underlined words 'or printed'

The purpose of this amendment is to allow certificates
of death to be printed as well as typewritten.
