COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 309, L. D. 975, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Unlawful Usurpation of Community Antennae  
Television System Signals and Injury to its Equipment."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement  
of Fact, the following underlined paragraph:

'This section shall not apply to the employees or agents of any  
public utility which permits the attachment to its poles of any  
such wire, cable, conduit, apparatus or equipment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt employees and  
agents of public utilities from the operation of the provisions  
of the bill being amended.
