COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 315, L.D. 981, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Time Period for Use of Marriage Certificate."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 19, § 62, amended. The 3rd sentence from the end of  
section 62 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and  
replaced by section 1 of chapter 330 of the public laws of 1971,  
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Any certificate is void if not used within 60 days from the day the  
intentions are filed in the office of the municipal clerks.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the law due to the  
fact that physical examinations are no longer required prior to  
marriage.
