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**AN ACT** Relating to Time Period for Use of Marriage Certificate.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 19, § 61, amended.** Section 61 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

**The marriage certificate must be used within 60 days from the date the intentions are filed in the office of the municipal clerk. The certificate shall be void after said date.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to provide for a time period during which marriage certificates must be used.
