Amend said Bill in the 7th line of section 2 (6th line of L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$100" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$400'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line of section 2 (7th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$200" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$500'
