COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 320, L. D. 987, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to License Fees and Penalties for Nonresidents  
in the Private Detective Business."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line of section 2 (6th line of  
L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$100" and inserting  
in place thereof the underlined figure '\$400'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line of section 2 (7th  
line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$200" and  
inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$500'
