COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 322, L. D. 989, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide a Portion of all Public Places and Transportation
Vehicles to be Set Aside for Nonsmokers."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line (4th line
in L.D.) the underlined word "establishments" and inserting in
place thereof the following: 'enclosed establishments in excess
of 1,500 square feet'

Further amend said Bill in the 9th line (7th line of L.D.)
by inserting after the underlined word "vehicles" the underlined
words and figure 'employed for carrying more than 10 passengers'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to define no-smoking areas.
