
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 322, L.D. 989, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Portion of all Public Places and Transportation Vehicles to be Set Aside for Nonsmokers."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines (7th and 8th lines in L.D.) after the enacting clause, the underlined word "shall" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'may'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to permit, not require, establishments to provide areas for the protection of non-smokers.
