STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Premises of Liquor Licensees to Proximity to
Post-secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 301, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 301 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The commission may grant licenses to premises which are within 300 feet of a church, chapel ~~or~~, parish house ~~or~~ **post-secondary school**, measured as aforesaid ~~and which do not adjoin any of the same~~, when the application therefor has the unanimous approval of the members of the commission and the written approval of a majority of the officers or the written approval of the officer, person or pastor in charge of such church, chapel ~~or~~, parish house ~~or~~ **post-secondary school**.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will allow trustees to approve licensed premises within 300 feet of school property.
