HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 761, L.D. 994, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Definition of Class A Restaurant under Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end, before the Statement of Fact, a new sentence to read as follows:

'In addition to the requirements of this section in places having a population of 5,000 or less and doing a minimum of \$10,000 per year in sales and service of food to the public, applicants must have the approval of the commission.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require approval of the State Liquor Commission in places of 5,000 or less population doing a minimum of \$10,000 per year in sales and service of food to the public.
