STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, In Favor of Penobscot County for Expenses in Guarding a Certain Prisoner.

Penobscot County; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the County of Penobscot the sum of \$4,264 as a full and final settlement and reimbursement to it for expenses paid to Eastern Maine Medical Center for certain medical aid.

STATEMENT OF FACT

William Mixer was alleged to have murdered his wife on October 23, 1972 at Brewer. The County of Penobscot incurred expenses for guards to guard this prisoner while he was in the hospital.
