STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Permit Elevator Repair by Unlicensed Personnel when Supervised by a Plant Engineer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 439, amended. The 2nd sentence of the first paragraph of section 439 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 312 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Elevator work in industrial plants, manufacturing plants and hospitals may be performed by plant personnel who are not licensed under sections 439 to 441, provided such work is supervised by the plant engineer.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 26, § 439, amended. Section 439 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 312 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

The word "plant" as used in this section shall mean industrial plant, manufacturing plant, hospitals and single occupancy structures having a full-time engineering and maintenance staff performing total in-plant maintenance.
