## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 106TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 858, L. D. 1001, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Recording Municipal Ordinances Relating to
Land Control."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
'§ 662-A. Municipal and control ordinances

Any municipality which adopts any ordinance which relates to land control, including, but not limited to, zoning and subdivisions, shall file and cause to be recorded a certified copy of such ordinance in the registry of deeds in the county or registry district wherein such municipality is located and said municipality shall forthwith transmit to said county or registry district any amendments to said ordinance, provided that no such ordinance or amendment shall have the force and effect of law until it has been duly filed and recorded.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent an ordinance from becoming effective until recorded.
