COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 768, L. D. 1002,
Resolve, to Authorize Granting an Easement on State Land
to Auburn Sewerage District.

Amend said resolve by inserting before the first
paragraph the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, in order to protect the health and welfare of the
people served by the Auburn Sewerage District the following
legislation is vitally necessary; and

Whereas, it is essential that the easement be granted so
that the sewer lines of the Auburn Sewerage District may be
constructed as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said resolve by inserting before the Statement
of Fact the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
