HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 770, L. D. 1004, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Temporary Restraining Order and Cost of Litigation by the Attorney General under Unfair Trade Practices Act."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end the following: 'In any action under this section where a permanent injunction is not issued, the court may order the State to pay the costs of the suit, including attorney's fees.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the court to order the State to pay the costs of the suit if a permanent injunction is not issued.
