SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 770, L. D. 1004, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Temporary Restraining Order and Cost of
Litigation by the Attorney General under Unfair Trade Practices
Act."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "including attorney's fees, and the investigation of that person by the Attorney General,"
