AN ACT Reestablishing a Base Period for all Fishing Regulations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1961, amended. Section 1961 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

Fishing regulations as set forth in the 1972 Open Water Regulations booklet and supplement and the 1973 Ice Fishing Regulations booklet are hereby declared to be official as printed. Changes in these regulations shall be made according to procedures established in section 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would reestablish a base period for all fishing regulations. The last general up-dating of fishing regulations occurred in 1955.
