**RESOLVE, Designating a Certain Bridge Across the Androscoggin River as
"The Veterans Memorial Bridge."**

"Veterans Memorial Bridge" designated. Resolved: That whereas the Viet Nam War has recently been concluded; and

Whereas, during said war 25 sons of Lewiston and Auburn gave their lives for their country and the cause of peace; and

Whereas, it is the desire of these communities that those who made the ultimate sacrifice during this war should be appropriately remembered; and that the bridge which is part of Maine State Project No. 918-1 (502) be named "The Veterans Memorial Bridge;" and be it further

Resolved: That appropriate plaques bearing the names of said men be erected at appropriate locations in Lewiston and in Auburn on the approaches to or on the bridge itself as the Department of Transportation may select; and be it further

Resolved: That appropriate signs designating the name of this bridge be erected on the bridge itself or the approaches thereto as the Department of Transportation may select.
