
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 335, L. D. 1034, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Department of the Attorney General to Print Reports of Two Attorneys General."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd line after the enacting clause (2nd and 3rd line in L. D.) the words "for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 6th line after the enacting clause (5th line in L. D.) which reads as follows: "1972-73"
