AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County
Attorney of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 3rd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Aroostook County, is amended to read as follows: county attorney, \$8,500 \$12,000; assistant county attorney, \$5,500 \$8,500.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$9,750 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
