HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 787,  
L. D. 1039, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Snowmobile Laws."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph.

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 5th  
paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 11 by inserting at the end  
of paragraph A of subsection 6 the following: 'and snowmobiles  
manufactured after October 1, 1973 but on or before February  
1, 1975 may be operated without reference to the requirements  
of this subsection concerning noise limit of 78 decibels of  
sound pressure;'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 6th  
paragraph.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to:

1. Clarify the operation of a snowmobile by a child under  
10 years of age.
2. Have the bill as to snowmobiles manufactured apply to those  
manufactured on or before October 1, 1973 rather than February  
1, 1975.
3. Grandfather the noise level of snowmobiles manufactured  
between October 1, 1973 and February 1, 1975 so that they may  
be operated after the stricter requirements come into being.
