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

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1044, Bill, "AN ACT
Pertaining to Unlicensed Dogs."

Amend said Bill in the 5th and 6th lines (4th and 5th lines of L.D.)
by striking out the following: "within the month of ~~April~~ January"
and inserting in place thereof the following: '~~within-the-month-of~~
between January 1st and April 30th'

Statement of Fact

At present unlicensed dogs are allowed to be kept for over
3 months before a warrant is issued by the municipal officers.
This amendment would allow for a warrant to be issued and the
owner or keeper of dogs not licensed after the January 1st due
date to be fined.
