COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 810, L.D. 1056, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Redemption Value of Trading Stamps."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of
fact and before the period, the following underlined words: 'by
redeeming stamps for merchandise'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to limit the cash redemption
value of stamps to the highest such value offered by the company in
any jurisdiction where it redeems stamps for cash or merchandise.
