HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 821, L. D. 1058, Bill,
"AN ACT Giving Powers of Arrest to State House Security Officer."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following underlined sentence:

'Any such officer appointed and employed under this section shall not be permitted to carry firearms without a prescribed course in training as authorized by the director.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require training in the use of firearms before security officers are permitted to carry the same.
