STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Allow Sales Tax Exemption for Veterans Organizations for Materials Purchased for Capital Improvements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 16-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 16-A to read as follows:
- 16-A. Veterans organizations. Sales of materials used directly and exclusively for repairs to, renovations to or additions, or both, to existing tax exempt properties owned by veterans organizations.
