AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County
Attorneys of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 4th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorneys of Cumberland County, is amended to read as follows:

county attorney, ~~\$10,000~~ \$13,500; first assistant county attorney, ~~\$7,000~~ \$9,500; second assistant county attorney, ~~\$7,000~~ \$9,500; third assistant county attorney, ~~\$7,000~~ \$9,500:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$16,500 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
