STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Number of Members of the Augusta Parking District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 124, § 4, sub-§ (b), amended. Subsection (b) of section 4 of chapter 124 of the private and special laws of 1947 is amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence the following new sentence:

Commencing with the year 1974, 3 members shall be appointed to replace the member whose term expires in the year 1974 and they shall serve a term of 3 years.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 124, § 4, sub-§ (b), amended. The 7th sentence of subsection (b) of section 4 of chapter 124 of the private and special laws of 1947 is amended to read as follows:

Two Three members of the district shall constitute a quorum, and the district may act by majority vote.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the members of the Augusta Parking District from 3 to 5.
