**AN ACT Relating to Definition of Agricultural Labor in the Employment
Security Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1043, sub-§ 1, amended. The last paragraph of subsection 1 of section 1043 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 538 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

This subsection shall not be deemed to be applicable with respect to service performed in connection with commercial canning or freezing ~~or the commercial~~, hatching ~~or processing~~ of poultry, ~~grading of eggs or packing of eggs~~ or the processing of any meat product.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill excludes from agricultural employment the commercial processing of poultry and meat products. This bill will cover employees in this industry under the unemployment compensation program.
