HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 828, L. D. 1087, Bill,
"AN ACT Preventing a Lien on Real Estate When Owner has Paid
Contractor."

Amend said Bill in the last line before the Statement
of Fact by inserting before the period the following:
', if said labor, materials or services were furnished
in connection with one single dwelling structure containing
not more than 5 dwelling units'
