HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 361, L. D. 1107, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to the Practice of Optometry."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§ 2595." by striking out in the 2nd and 3rd lines the underlined
words and punctuation "person, firm, partnership, company or
corporation" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
words 'optometrist licensed hereunder'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to make it clear that the statute
regulating the practice of optometry applies only to such
practice and not to the bona fide activities of others engaged
in the sale of eye wear.
