AN ACT Reimbursing Teachers for Professional Credits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1902, amended. The first sentence, as repealed and replaced by chapter 177 of the public laws of 1967 and the 2nd sentence, as enacted by chapter 177 of the public laws of 1967 and as amended, of section 1902 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, are repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The 2 sentences which this bill would repeal relate to a now out-dated procedure for reimbursing teachers for professional study. The area of course reimbursement is a negotiable issue which is now provided for in most collective bargaining agreements. In addition, the provision relating to reimbursement by the State is no longer being done as the "foundation program" approach to school subsidy was repealed in 1969.
