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**AN ACT** Eliminating Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's License Pending Appeal in Operating under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquors.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** R. S., T. 29, § 1312, sub-§ 2, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of subsection 2 of section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 547 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Any suspension shall **not** remain in effect pending the outcome of such hearing, if requested.

**Sec. 2.** R. S., T. 29, § 1312, sub-§ 10, ¶ A, amended. The last paragraph of paragraph A of subsection 10 of section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 547 of the public laws of 1971, is repealed.
