## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Railroad Companies to Erect and Maintain Bridge Guards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 820, repealed. Section 820 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Bridge guards not now necessary because train crews no longer work on top of moving freight cars.
