AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Railroad Companies to Erect and
Maintain Bridge Guards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 820, repealed. Section 820 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Bridge guards not now necessary because train crews no longer work on top of moving freight cars.
