STATE OF MAINE SENATE 106TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 387, L.D. 1133, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Liquor Purchased from State Liquor Stores."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R.S., T. 28, § 204, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 204 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 44 of chapter 590 of the public laws of 1969, and as amended by section 1 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1971, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The commission shall sell to such licensee spirituous and vinous liquor, except table wine, for a price no higher than the lowest retail price in any State retail store.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this Amendment to eliminate the 10% discount on sales to licensees.
