COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 388, L. D. 1134, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Competitive Bids and Fair Minimum Wages for
Construction of Public Improvements."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the words "and Fair Minimum Wages"

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$25,000'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 8th and 9th lines (6th and 7th lines in L.D.) the following: "in-accordance-with-chapters-14t-to-155 and such other" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'in accordance with chapters 141 to 155 and such other'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 11th line (9th line of L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$25,000'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment reinstates the language of the existing statute and sets the sum of \$25,000 as the determining figure for the use of systems to award contracts.
